





BROOKE FARMS

Brooke Farms, LLC was established in 1989 by Bob and Missy Chambers. Bob and Missy both grew up on farms in West Virginia. When they moved to Stafford County, Virginia in 1987, their love of farming came also. Bob started leasing land and collecting ag equipment. In 1997, Bob and Missy purchased 412 acres, previously known as The Mason Farm, in Locust Grove, Virginia. Over the years, Brooke Farms, LLC has had a variety of adventures from row crops to beef cattle. In 2015, they were honored to host the 2015 VA Ag Expo with the help of their two sons, Bobby and Garret. In 2018 Garret and his wife, Lexie, began the farm transition which was completed in 2020.

Today, Brooke Farms, LLC consists of 2,700 acres of crop and pasture ground covering 75 miles over 3 counties. On this land, they grow corn, soybeans, wheat, horse hay and straw. Brooke Farms, LLC also consists of 160 spring calving cows and feedlot facility capable of finishing out the calves produced. Currently Brooke Farms, LLC has 1 full time employee and 3 part-time employees. As they look to the future, Garret and Lexie are excited to continue to grow the operation in hopes to one day pass it down to their children.

Bob, Missy, Garret and Lexie are excited to host the 2025 Virginia Ag Expo! We are looking forward to a wonderful day on the farm.

ADVANCED AGRONOMY EDUCATION
